The year 2013 marks the 36th year of Haddam Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc., (HVAS), caring for the townspeople of Haddam. In those 36 years, we have helped thousands of individuals who were in need of emergency medical care.

HVAS continues to focus on retention and recruitment of new medical members to continue to support the emergency medical needs of Haddam and Higganum residents. In the past year, HVAS responded to 600 requests for emergency medical services including diabetic and cardiac related emergencies, those involved in automobile and boating accidents, and those with serious medical illnesses and injuries.

HVAS prides itself on being an active member of the community as it participates in a variety of events including: H-K SADD Drill, Pumpkin Run, Haddam Club 60, school visits, and the Memorial Day parade. HVAS can offer Friends and Family CPR classes for interested parties free of charge. HVAS is also called upon to do wellness checks in cases of severe weather.
